The HIGHLIGHTS:

- program includes all Olympic competitions + all 50m + 100m medley
- short course (25m), electronic timing, 6 lanes
- open class only

- in total **9,100 €** prize money (also for 2nd and 3rd places)
- prize money for the best over-all performance according to the FINA-points table (**250 €**) for the best male and female swimmer
- best conditions for the athletes: fast pool, Omega start blocks, backstroke start wedges (FINA approved), limited number of heats
- opportunity for paralympic swimmers to participate

Rules and regulations

1. Rules and Conditions of Participation

The meeting will be staged according to the rules (WB and RO) and the anti-doping regulations (ADO) of the German Swimming Federation (DSV). For handicapped swimmers with the appropriate classification of evidence the rules and regulations of the German Disabled Sports Federation (DBS) will be in force additionally. The meeting is open to all clubs and teams of federations associated to FINA. For German clubs we refer to the special regulations of the DSV (please see also the German version of this invitation).

When submitting the entries, the club has to confirm that its athletes are healthy to do sports.

2. Registration

2.1. Pre-registration

We would be pleased to receive a pre-registration at isf@asv06.de till 01.09.2022, so that we can arrange all required preparations for your stay in Aachen.

If possible, please send your entries as DSV-6.0 or Lennex 3.0 data files. Corresponding templates are available on the competition website (<http://isf.asv06.de>).

Official results from the timespan of September 1, 2021 to September 25, 2022 must be used **entry times**.

Please send your entries by **Sunday, September 25, 2022**. If you don't receive a confirmation of your entries within 24h after submitting, please contact us immediately (by phone).

2.3. Limitation of entries

We limit the number of heats **in the best interest of a high-class competition** (refer also to column „L.H.“ in the table on page 2). The swimmers with the fastest entry times (please also see paragraph 2.2) will be accepted. Additional 8 swimmers will be put on the reserve list for each event. The corresponding startlist (including reserve swimmers) will be published on October 2, 2022.

The given **standard times** in the program are based on the results of the last years and shall be understood as follows: you will be likely accepted if your entry time is below the standard time.

We reserve the right to reserve 2 starting places per event for the swimmers of the organizing ASV06 e.V. We reserve the right to reserve 2 starting places per event for paralympic swimmers.

2.4. Registration fee

The entry fee is 12,00 € for each individual start and 20,00 € for relays. The entry fee can only be transferred to the bank account of the Aachener Schwimmverein 06 e.V.

The entry fee must be transferred until Wednesday, October 12, 2022, otherwise the club/team is not allowed to start. The possible overpaid money (from athletes on the reserve list) will be paid back via bank transfer. We

therefore ask you to include your bank details (IBAN and BIC/SWIFT-Code) in your registration.

If a club does not participate, the duty of payment still persists.

3. Competition

The swim meet will be held at "Schwimmhalle Ost", St.-Josefs-Platz 8, 52068 Aachen (Germany). The pool consists of 6 lanes and is 25m long (short course). The lanes are separated by wave-killing lines. The temperature of water is at least 26° Celsius, the depth varies from 1.80m – 3.80m.

Electronic timing (system Omega) will be used. The one-start-rule will be used (see §125 sec. 6 WB (DSV)). The start list will be arranged according to §121-§123 WB (DSV). The start signal will be given in English.

Backstroke start wedges will be in use.

4. Referees

Clubs with more than 20 entries shall bring one referee.

Further referees will be organized by the organizing club in cooperation with "swimming district Aachen".

5. Rewards

The ranking only consists of open class. The three best swimmers of each event receive medals. The prize money is regulated by paragraph 10 of this invitation.

6. Mixed-medley relay

The relay has to be swum in the ordinary order: back-breast-fly-free. Two women and two men have to swim, but their order is arbitrary. Also teams on a national or federational level are allowed.

7. Spectators

Spectators can probably be admitted to the meet. Further information and entrance fee will be published in due time on the event website <http://isf.asv06.de>.

8. Hygiene Concept

The ASV 06 will develop an event-related hygiene concept due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The special rules contained therein (including testing, accreditation, behavior in the competition venue, warming up, use of sanitary facilities, etc.) must be obeyed. In case of violations, exclusion from the event is possible.

With the hygiene concept will be made available by the organizer before the start of the competition. Depending on the course of the pandemic, the organizer may make changes to the rules or implementation at short notice, including the duration of the event or the participants. If the meet needs to be canceled at short notice, the registration fees already paid will be refunded immediately.

9. Privacy

With the registration, the club or swimmer accepts the invitation and the rules of the competition. The club and/or the swimmer agree to the storage of personal data. Permission is also given to publish event information. On top the club and/or swimmer also declares that all provided data, all photos and videos taken at the meet can be used for media and sponsors without compensation.



10. Prize money

Up to **9,100 €** in prize money will be awarded. The money is distributed according to the following system:

A. Sprint Rating

There is prize money available in the following categories for men and women:

In each category, the highest score will be determined according to the FINA points-table (edition 2016, short course). If a swimmer starts in prelim and final, the better time will be taken. In each category the three best swimmers (male and female) get a prize money of **100 €, 50 € and 30 €** respectively.

B. Sprint Rating

In the prelims of all 50m-competitions and 100m ind. medley the 8 fastest swimmers will get points: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1. The three best swimmers with the highest score from all 5 competitions will be awarded a prize money of 250 €, 150 € and 100 € respectively.

C. Relays

The three best teams receive **240 €, 120 € and 80 €**, respectively.

D. Special Rating

The swimmer who gains the highest score in a single race (FINA table, short course) will get a prize money of 250 € each. Men and women are awarded separately.

E. Record Reward

For each new Festival record a premium of 50 € will be awarded. If no new record is set up for an event, the prize money will be passed into a record jackpot. This means that next year the prize money will be 100 € for this event and so on. But the jackpot is limited to 150 €. You can see the amount for each event in the program table.

If a record is set up in a prelim, the prize money will only be given when the swimmer also starts in the final of this event. If more than one swimmer breaks the record, only the fastest swimmer will get the reward and will be published as record holder.

Prize money and awards must be received in person. Otherwise they will be forfeited to the organizer (ASV 06).

This invitation was shown to the swimming officer of Swimming District Aachen (Schwimmbezirk Aachen), Wilfried Bisdorf.

In case of any disagreement between this invitation and the German version, the German version is the relevant one.
